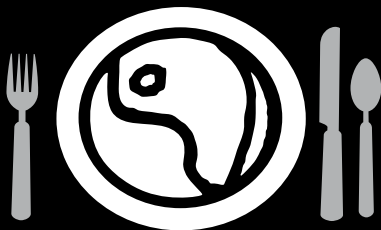

In Match Play, if the need for protest arises the protest must be made before the players strike off the next teeing ground and a report made to the Match Committee on the completion of the round.

In the event of a tie after 18 holes of HANDICAP MATCH PLAY, the match will be decided over the series of 3 holes.

All finals will be played over 18 holes, with the exception of the Finals of the Club Championships, which will be played over 36 holes.

New handicaps will take effect as soon as they are posted on the Handicap Board.

ALL competitions to be played on the Handicaps as shown on the Handicap Board.

Before commencing Handicap Match Play, players are responsible for verifying their handicaps. All matches to be played on the dates as set out in the programme except with permission of the Match Committee.

All Score Cards MUST be returned in Competitions.

Member's attention is drawn to the **LOCAL RULES** as shown on the Score Cards or the Noticeboard during the season.

Times booked MUST be adhered to and players should be ready to commence play 5 minutes before time set down in the time sheet.

LATE ARRIVAL FORFEITS POSITION ON TIME SHEET.

Times may be indicated by the Match Committee for some events.

NOTE: A SCORER SIGNING A CARD IS A TRUSTEE FOR ALL THE PLAYERS IN THE COMPETITION AND HE/SHE MUST BE SATISFIED AS TO ITS CORRECTNESS.

Waikato Golf Interclub Format 2018

Following our comprehensive review Survey of the Men's 2016 Interclub Competitions and Formats, we can now confirm both the competitions and formats that will be run for the 2017 season.

Championship Pennants

The format for championship pennants will be the same as in previous years, but with a limited entry of two teams per club. Each of Waikato Golf's affiliated clubs will be permitted to enter one or two teams.

The format is summarised below

- Limited to entry of two teams per club
- Format as currently – gross 18 hole match-play – Foursomes / Singles. Six Players per team.
- Divisions to be established based on seedings from last year's round robin results.
- Number of divisions to be determined on the basis of number of entries
- Same number in each divisions as in prior years (8)
- Promotion / Relegation as before
- No club can have two teams in the same division
- Not zoned.
- Divisions to be established based on seedings from last year's round robin results.
- Number of divisions to be determined on the basis of number of entries. We expect that the number of entries will be either 3 or 4 divisions depending on the number of participating clubs and teams.
- Finals will be played on a Neutral Course.
- A player Substituted in does not need to play in the position of the player being substituted. It is recommended that he play in his Singles OOM position in the team.

Handicap Matchplay Pennants

A new format was introduced in the 2015 season, to allow competition for players that would have previously played in the lower divisions of Championship Pennants, and to avoid some of the one sided matches which have been seen in these lower divisions. This competition proved to be very popular and highly successful and will be continued in 2017.

The format is summarised below

- Limited to entry of one team per club or 2 if only 1 team in Championship Pennants.
- Format 18 hole Handicap Match-play - Foursomes / Singles. Best net per hole (as per Prebble Cup). Six players per team,
- Teams shall play in handicap index order, i.e. the lowest handicapper will play No.1 and the highest handicapper No. 6. This will apply to both singles and foursomes. The maximum playing handicap index shall be 18.0.
- Played in 4 zones determined by the geographic location of entering clubs and number of club's entering.
- Zone winners will qualify for Semi Finals and Semi Final winners will qualify for Final. Semi Finals and Final to be played on a neutral venue on the same basis as the zone matches.
- Foursomes pairs, calculate 50% of the course combined Handicaps with 0.5 rounded up
- **Team Captains/Managers to submit Team playing sheet to convenor, listing playing order and Handicap Index, 15 Minutes prior to tee off.**

Handicap Stroke-play Pennants

Only one minor change to the format of this Competition, with the final to be played over 27 Holes on the one day at a neutral course.

The format is summarised below:

- Limited to entry of one team per club
- Stroke play 3 rounds of 27 holes 4 players/team. All scores to count. Played in 2 zones.
- Top 6 from each zone (plus ties) will qualify for Final
- Final to be held played over 27 Holes on the same day at a neutral course.
- WGA to determine Zones based on entries received.
- **Team Captains/Managers to submit Team playing sheet to convenor, listing playing order and Handicap Index, 15 Minutes prior to tee off.**

Prebble Cup / Tolich Trophy

1: Competition to be decided on match-play on a knock out basis. All matches are to be played under Lowest Nett per hole format.

2: Qualifying Round (If needed) and Round of 32 Losers, will compete in the Tolich Trophy competition to be run in conjunction with the main competition on the same knock out basis.

3: Teams to consist of eight players - four Seniors on Handicap Index 5.0 to 14.4 four Juniors on Handicap Index 14.5 to 24.0. Foursome's match-play; best nett wins the hole. Each pair's handicap is derived from 50 percent of their combined course handicaps.

4: Any player that is being substituted or replaced (in) MUST play in the position of the player being substituted/ replaced (out) in BOTH Foursomes & Singles. There is to be NO change to the playing order.

5: In all rounds, other than the final, the decision, in the event of matches being equal, to be decided by the margin of holes or subsequently by sudden death combined stableford play commencing at the first hole, the players to participate being one Senior and one Junior from each team tying, selected by respective captains. In the final round, should the matches and the margin of games be equal, the match to be replayed not necessarily on the same course.

6: Foursome matches in the morning, singles in the afternoon, unless determined by the convenor

7: One team per Club.

8: Results to be advised to the Association.

9: General Rules controlling the competition to be decided by the Waikato Golf Association (Inc.).

10: Team lists in playing order to be submitted as requested by the Waikato Golf Association.

11: Course Handicaps will be used on the day of competition.

12: Winner from the previous year has the right to host the final if their club is not involved in the current finals.

THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS WILL GOVERN THE LADIES PROGRAMME : 2018

If the match Committee deem it necessary to change the programme, it shall have the power to do so.
